CODART ACHTTIEN London

18-21 January 2015

After the success of the first Speakers' Corner held during CODART ZEVENTIEN in Amsterdam, the morning session on Tuesday, 20 January will feature a plenary Speakers' Corner again. Also during CODART ACHTTIEN in London CODART members will have an opportunity to give a short presentation of 7 minutes.

CODART members will be given the congress floor for seven minutes, during which time they can put (research)questions to their fellow curators, appeal to them for advice or seek partners for projects. After each presentation there will be time for reactions from the audience. The day's congress chair will keep an eye on the clock and lead the discussions.

Ideally, the presentations should tie in as much as possible with the theme of the congress, but this is not mandatory. Find the congress theme on the CODART website: www.codart.nl/663.

How to apply

Please fill in the application form and return it via events@codart.nl **before or on 1 September 2014**. CODART's program committee will evaluate the proposals and select the speakers, who will be given time on the podium.

Before the congress

If you choose to include a **PowerPoint** presentation, please keep it short. It must be sent before **8 January 2015** to events@codart.nl.

At the congress

Presentations should be timed to last **seven minutes**. Speakers will be given a sign just before their time is up; presentations are not allowed to exceed seven minutes. Afterwards speakers will be given a short period to answer questions from the audience.

If you would like to test your PowerPoint presentation beforehand, please report to our webmaster in the auditorium of the Wallace Collection from 9:00 am.
