CODART 25 Stockholm

16-18 June 2024

The first part of the morning session on Tuesday, 18 June at the Royal Academy of Fine Arts, Stockholm is dedicated to the plenary Speakers' Corner, where CODART members will have an opportunity to give a short presentation.

CODART members will be given the congress floor for **seven minutes**, during which time they can put (research)questions to their fellow curators, appeal to them for advice or seek partners for projects. Few limitations regarding the content of the presentations are set. However each participant must end their contribution with a concrete questions to which the other attendees can respond. The day's congress chair will keep an eye on the clock and lead the discussions.

How to apply

Please fill in the online application form on the CODART website **before or on 2 April 2024**. CODART's program committee will evaluate the proposals and select the speakers, who will be given time on the podium.

At the congress

Presentations should be timed to last **seven minutes or less**. Speakers will be given a sign just before their time is up; presentations are not allowed to exceed seven minutes. Afterwards the audience is given time to react on the speaker or ask further questions.
