How to apply

Please fill in the online application form on the CODART website **before or on 12 January 2026.**CODART's program committee will evaluate proposals based on the relevance, clarity and potential for discussion of your question or project. Selected speakers will be given time on the podium.

At the congress

Presentations should be timed to last **seven minutes or less**. Speakers will be given a sign just before their time is up; presentations are not allowed to exceed seven minutes. Afterwards the audience is given time (ca. 3 minutes) to respond to the presentation or ask further questions. The day's congress chair will keep an eye on the clock and lead the discussions.
